

## ***SPORTING REGULATIONS OF THE VAR PROVENCE VERTE MARATHON 2026***

*Updated version**Updated on January 28, 2026.*

### ***PREAMBLE***

*Organization: CREASPORTS ORGANISATION, a non-profit association under the French Law of 1901, SIRET number 423935212, with its registered office at 3 Impasse des Anémones, HYERES (83400), France. The CREASPORTS ORGANISATION association is hereinafter referred to as the Organizer.*

*The terms "you", "yours" and "yours" refer to you, as a participant or consumer, or to their parent or legal guardian (over 18 years of age) if that participant or consumer is a minor in their country of residence.*

*Participation in the Event implies your express and unreserved acceptance of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale and the Regulations.*

*This document supplements the Terms of Use for the online registration platform called NJUKO, accessible at: njuko.net*

*In the event of any conflict between the terms of the njuko.net Terms of Use, these General Terms and Conditions of Sale, and the Regulations, the terms of the Regulations shall prevail over the General Terms and Conditions of Sale, which shall in turn prevail over the njuko.net Terms of Use.*

*The Organizer may revise and update the General Terms and Conditions of Sale and the Regulations at any time; please consult them regularly. All changes will apply immediately upon notification, by any means, including the publication of a revised version on the Event website marathon-var-provence-verte.com*

*In the event of a significant change to the General Terms and Conditions of Sale and/or the Regulations, the Organizer will endeavor to notify you by email.*

### ***Important! Role of the njuko.net website***

*Njuko.net, through which you registered, allows professional organizers to list and sell their products and services. While the njuko.net platform facilitates transactions, njuko.net is not the seller or organizer of the products and services related to the Event.*

*In consequence, for the sale of products or services related to the Event, a sales contract is formed solely between you and the Organizer. The Organizer is responsible for the sales of products or services related to the Event and for any claims or other issues arising from or related to the sales contract between you and the Organizer.*

## ***I. SPORTS REGULATIONS***

*These sporting regulations (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations) apply to all participants in the Event. They form an integral part of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale referred to above. In the event of any conflict with the provisions of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale, the provisions of these Regulations shall prevail.*

### ***1.1. THE PATHS***

*The event routes are respectively:*

- The 10.7km, 21.1km, and 42.195km races will take place on roads and country lanes, in accordance with the international road race regulations (IAAF and FFA). The marathon can be run as a relay in teams of 2 or 5. The Duo Run and Bike event will be held over the marathon distance.
- New 26km race. Start in the village of Rocbaron, cross through Saint Anastasie and Camps la source and finish at the Marathon village in Brignoles.
- The Marathon Hike: Approximately 15km, starting from the village of Saint Anastasie, passing through the village of Camps la Source, then finishing at the Marathon village in Brignoles.
- on the heights of Brignoles
- L'The walking activity for children will be 1 to 2km.

**1.2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION – LICENSE – MEDICAL CERTIFICATE**

*To participate in the Event, you must be at least:*

- 16 years old (sixteen) at the latest by December 31, 2026 for the 10.7km
- 18 years old (eighteen) at the latest by December 31, 2026 for the half marathon, the Run and Bike.
- 20 (twenty) years old at the latest by December 31, 2026 for the solo marathon and the trail runners.
- 16 years (sixteen) at the latest by December 31, 2026 for the Team relay marathon (5 runners but only on the two shortest relays)

*The age categories will be ranked separately in accordance with the FFA (French Athletics Federation). Please note that checks will be carried out during the event to ensure fair and consistent racing conditions, particularly regarding age requirements and medical certification. By participating in the Event, you are taking part in one of the sporting events organized or sanctioned by the sports federations. Therefore, your participation is subject to the mandatory presentation of:*

*-A sports license from the French Athletics Federation (FFA) for running or competition is required. FFTRI licenses are no longer accepted for participation in FFA races since January 1, 2019.*

- For non-licensed athletes to whom these competitions are open, presentation of a PPS (Health Prevention Pathway, document to be completed online on the FFA website - <https://pps.athle.fr>)*

**IMPORTANT!** Participants residing abroad: You are required to provide a medical certificate stating that there are no contraindications to participating in competitive athletics or running, even if you hold a competition license issued by a federation affiliated with the IAAF. This certificate must be dated, signed, and allow for the authentication of the physician, whether or not they are based in

France. If the physician is from another country, the medical certificate must be written in French or English.

**Mandatory Information on the Medical Certificate:** Your medical certificate must state "no contraindication to the practice of athletics in competition" or "no contraindication to the practice of running in competition." FSCF, FSGT, and UFOLEP competition licenses are accepted if they explicitly state "athletics." Other licenses are not accepted.

FFA members will benefit from automatic license verification during online registration. If the online form validates your FFA membership, there is no need to upload your license. Other documents submitted online to the Sportips.fr website will be checked. You will receive an automated message informing you whether your document is validated or invalidated.

On-site verification of the authenticity of medical certificates and licenses may be carried out.

### 1.3. BIB COLLECTION

Race bibs can be collected upon presentation of the following documents:

- Your license, PPS or medical certificate for foreigners meeting the conditions mentioned above,
- Your identity document.

Race bibs can be collected exclusively at the Marathon Village located in Brignoles 83170, on Friday, May 1st, 2026, from 9:30 am to 7:00 pm and on Saturday, May 2nd, 2026, before the start of the races. The bib number must be fully legible during the race, even in inclement weather.

A person will be able to collect their team's race numbers if all team documents are up to date and copies of identity cards are presented.

*The price of race bibs is expressed in this document in Euros, including all taxes, at the rate in effect on the day of your registration.*

*All registrations for an Event are personal, firm and final, and cannot be refunded for any reason whatsoever.*

*Runners have the option to purchase cancellation insurance at the time of their registration. Please note that without this insurance, no refund will be issued.*

*Each registration entitles the holder to a race bib. No transfer of race bib is permitted for any reason whatsoever.*

*Any person transferring their race number to a third party will be held responsible in the event of an accident caused by or involving that third party during the event.*

*The organization declines all responsibility in the event of an accident in this type of situation.*

*When registering as a team, team members' names can be changed free of charge until April 20, 2026. After this date, changes will be possible until May 1, 2026, but at a cost of €10 per name changed. No changes will be permitted on May 1 and 2, 2026.*

### *Engagement Club, CE, group:*

*Please note that a group leader will need to be designated, and it will be he or she who will collect the race bibs and equipment for the entire group.*

*When the group is created, and from the first registration, the person in charge will receive a link with which they can add runners over the weeks.*

*He/she will also be able to transfer this link to people in his/her group so that they can add themselves.*

## **1.5. OFFICIAL JURY**

*It consists of a race director, whose decision-making power is final. The director is assisted by judges and race officials. Aid stations are located approximately every 5 km, as well as at the finish line. Participants will have a maximum of 6 hours to complete the 42.195 km course and 4 hours for the Half Marathon. After the passage of the final vehicle, participants must comply with the traffic laws.*

#### **1.7. GENERAL SERVICES**

*The road safety is ensured by marshals and police services, while medical services are provided by Civil Protection. These services may decide to disqualify a participant for medical reasons.*

#### **1.8. SITE ACCESS AND SECURITY**

*The introduction onto the Event site of any objects that may be dangerous or illegal, including drugs, firearms, blunt objects and explosive materials, is strictly prohibited.*

*To access the site and participate in the Event, participants expressly acknowledge and accept that the Organizer may employ security personnel authorized to check both individuals and their belongings. Anyone wishing to access the site agrees to submit to this check. Refusal will result in denied access. The Organizer and security personnel are authorized to refuse entry to the Event or prevent participants from continuing the race if their behavior is likely to disrupt the smooth running of the Event, including, but not limited to: bringing any object that could potentially hinder the progress of the race, traffic flow, and/or the safety of other participants in any way; or bringing any distinctive symbol promoting, in any form whatsoever, a political, philosophical, or religious opinion that could damage the image of the Event.*

#### **1.9.1 TIMING**

*All participants will receive an electronic timing chip when they collect their race bib (the chip is a small strip attached to the back of each bib). This chip will be automatically activated at the starting line and will be used to verify race compliance at several points along the course. Any participant who deviates from the designated course route will not be ranked at the finish.*

*Regarding the 5 or 2 runner relay marathon, the passing of the bib number positioned on the bib holder will be mandatory in order to ensure the timing of each relay runner and to establish the overall time of the 42.195km.*

*Regarding the Run And Bike Marathon, the two runners with their respective bib numbers must pass the course checkpoints and the finish line together.*

*The electronic detection system is selected according to strict reliability criteria. Despite tests carried out by manufacturers, a very small percentage of non-detections always occur. Due to the lack of data resulting from these non-detections, we have a system that records all arrivals and allows us to reclassify them if necessary.*

*Since the departure points are different from the arrival point, shuttles are organized to take you to the starting points. See the Shuttles tab for details.*

**TRANSPORTATION:**

*Shuttle buses will be scheduled to take you to the starting point. You will find all the information and timetables on the website under the "Shuttles - Luggage Storage" tab.*

**-VAR PROVENCE VERTE MARATHON TEAMS OF 5:**

*The "relay" event will follow the route of the "individual" event of the Var Provence Verte Marathon.*

*The start of the relay race will be given simultaneously with the start of the individual Marathon race on May 2, 2026 at 9:00 am.*

*The finish line will be located on Cours Liberté in Brignoles. The race route can be viewed in the "Race" section of the event website.*

*Bibs During bib distribution, each team will receive 5 individual bibs (to be worn on the back) plus one bib (to be worn on the front). This bib will be attached to a bib belt and will serve as a baton for passing the baton between teammates.*

**TRANSPORTATION:**

*Shuttle buses will be scheduled to take you to the starting points and relay points. You will find all the information and timetables on the website under the "Shuttles - Luggage Storage" tab.*

**-VAR PROVENCE VERTE MARATHON TEAMS OF 2:**

*LThe "relay" event will follow the route of the "individual" event of the Var Provence Verte Marathon. The relay will take place in Carcès at the half marathon.*

*The start of the relay race will be given simultaneously with the start of the individual Marathon race on May 2, 2026 at 9:00 am.*

*The finish line will be located on Cours Liberté in Brignoles. The race route can be viewed in the "Race" section of the event website.*

*Bibs During bib distribution, each team will receive two individual bibs (to be worn on the back) plus one bib (to be worn on the front). This bib will be attached to a bib belt and will serve as the baton exchange point during the relay between teammates.*

**TRANSPORTATION:**

*Shuttle buses will be scheduled to take you to the starting points and relay points. You will find all the information and timetables on the website under the "Shuttles - Luggage Storage" tab.*

**-RUN AND BIKE MARATHON:**

*One mountain bike for two (electric mountain bikes not allowed)*

*Wearing a helmet is mandatory on the bicycle*

*The two teammates must stay close together (10m maximum).*

**Procedure:**

*Only one teammate will start the marathon at 9:00 AM; the other teammate will wait for their partner a few kilometers later in the village of Correns. From this meeting point, they will complete the course together and switch between runner and cyclist as they wish. They must cross the finish line and all checkpoints together to be ranked.*

*Bibs: During the bib collection, each team will be given 2 bibs to wear on the front.*

**TRANSPORTATION:**

*Participants in the Run and Bike Marathon must make their own way to Chateauvert, where parking is available. Runners will start with the individual marathon and marathon relay teams, while cyclists must travel to Correns by bicycle and wait for their teammate at the junction point.*

*After the event, shuttle buses will be available between the finish line in Brignoles and your vehicle in Chateauvert. You will find all the information and schedules on the website under the "Shuttles - Luggage Storage" tab.*

#### **TRAIL VAR PROVENCE VERTE**

*Required equipment: A water reserve of at least 1.50l, a mobile phone.*

*Rain gear in case of bad weather.*

*A shuttle bus departing from Brignoles will drop you off in Rocbaron.*

*You will find all the information and timetables on the website under the "Shuttles - Luggage Storage" tab.*

#### **The MARATHON HIKE:**

*No medical certificate is required for your commitment.*

*A supply post at Camps.*

*Required equipment: A water supply of at least 1.5 liters and a mobile phone*

*Rain gear in case of bad weather.*

*A shuttle bus departing from Brignoles will drop you off at Sainte Anastasie*

*You will find all the information and timetables on the website under the "Shuttles - Luggage Storage" tab.*

### **1.10. INSURANCE**

*Civil Liability: In accordance with applicable legislation, the Organizer has taken out insurance covering the financial consequences of its civil liability, that of its employees, and that of all participants in the Event. Regarding the civil liability of participants, this insurance coverage is limited to accidents they may cause during the Event. This coverage will apply in addition to, or in the absence of, any other insurance that participants may have. Proof of insurance can be provided to any participant upon request.*

*Individual accident: the organization recommends that all participants who do not have personal insurance covering their bodily injuries, particularly those not licensed with a sports federation, take out individual accident insurance as part of their participation in the event.*

*This insurance is optional but strongly recommended. It can be purchased in addition to, or in lieu of, similar insurance held, for example, through a sports license. The information leaflet and membership form are available on the Event website (Registration -> Insurance).*

*Property damage: The Organizer accepts no responsibility for any damage (theft, breakage, loss, etc.) to participants' personal belongings, even if the Organizer is in their custody. Participants may not hold the Organizer liable for any damage to their equipment. It is the responsibility of each participant to obtain insurance coverage for such risks.*

### **1.11. USE OF IMAGES**

#### **1.11.1. Participant image:**

*The Event may be recorded for public communication in any form (including photos, videos, etc.), on any existing or future medium, in any format, for any public communication worldwide, for any use, including advertising and/or commercial purposes. Each participant expressly authorizes the Organizer, its successors and assigns (including its commercial partners) to record and reproduce,*

*on any medium and by any means, and consequently, to reproduce and display, without any compensation whatsoever, their name, voice, image, and more generally their sporting performance within the context of the Event (hereinafter "their Image"), for a period not exceeding 10 years following the date of the Event. The participant expressly authorizes the Organizer to grant sub-licenses to the Event's partners for the commercial and advertising use of their Image. To this end, each participant expressly and irrevocably authorizes the Organizer, its successors and assigns (including its commercial partners), in order to meet the requirements of advertising, promotional and/or commercial campaigns to:*

- 1) to make any modification, addition, or deletion that it deems necessary for the use of its Image under the conditions defined above,*
- 2) to associate and/or combine with its Image, all signatures, taglines, slogans, legends, trademarks, distinctive signs, legal notices, visuals and, in general, any element of any kind chosen by the Organizer intended in particular to illustrate the communication materials in which they are integrated.*

*The participant guarantees that they are not bound by any exclusive contract relating to the use of their image.*

*The participant is informed and accepts without reservation that their participation in the Event involves the recording of their image by the Organizer's official service providers. Their image, reproduced in photo and/or video format, will be accessible on the sportips.fr website in the "My Account" section and for one year on the Event website in the "Results" section. Regarding the Event website, the participant accepts that they may be identified by any internet user by their first and last name, bib number, and region.*

#### **1.11.2. Images of the Event:**

*Any communication of still image and/or animated sequence of the Event captured by the participant during their participation in the Event must be limited to personal use and may not under any circumstances be used for promotional and/or commercial purposes outside of the Event.*

#### **1.12. PERSONAL DATA**

*From a general perspective, the personal data communicated by the participants (hereinafter "the Data") is intended for the authorized staff of the Organizer, which is the company responsible for processing this data.*

*To learn about the Organizer's Data Protection Policy, please refer to the General Terms and Conditions of Sale (I). As an Event Participant, we also encourage you to carefully read the following provisions:*

*You acknowledge that any user of the live tracking application or the internet may be able to follow the participants in the Event by entering their name and/or surname and/or bib number. Following the Event, information related to your sporting performance (including your result, photos, and videos) will be published on the Event website. Your results may be used by any media outlet.*

*If you wish to object to the publication of your first and last names in the rankings, it is possible, but this action will necessarily be declared to the FFA, and is definitively irreversible for all your future FFA races.*

*If you wish to object to such publication for a legitimate reason, you must communicate this decision to the Organizer at CREASPORTS ORGANISATION 3 Imp des Anémones, 83400 Hyères in*

advance of the Event and no later than 20 days before the latter so that appropriate measures can be taken.

#### 1.14. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

Your participation At an ECO MARATHON, we implement numerous measures to ensure the event is as "clean" as possible. To respect the environment and the natural areas traversed, it is strictly forbidden to leave any waste (paper, plastic packaging, etc.) on the course.

We prohibit the use of amateur and professional drones on the course and in the vicinity of the event.

When you collect your race bib you will be given a cup (lightweight and foldable), you will need to run with it to be able to refuel.

**THERE WILL BE NO OTHER CUPS ON THE COURSE OR AT THE FINISH LINE**

Bins will be available at each aid station and "collection zones" will be set up and marked at various points along the route. Participants must use them.

Participants must keep their waste and packaging until they reach the locations indicated by the Organizer to dispose of it.

The Organizer reserves the right to assign time penalties or disqualify participants or their team who willfully throw their waste outside the designated areas.

#### 1.15. EQUIPMENT PROHIBITED ON THE COURSE

Bicycles (excluding Run and Bike participants), wheeled and/or motorized vehicles are strictly prohibited on the course.

#### 1.16. ANTI-DOPING FIGHT

The Event may be subject to anti-doping controls. Participants in the Event undertake to strictly respect the ban on doping as well as the provisions concerning anti-doping controls, as set out in the laws and regulations in force, in particular articles L.230-1 et seq. of the Sports Code.

#### 1.17. MODIFICATION – POSTPONEMENT – CANCELLATION

If circumstances require it, the Organizer reserves the right to modify at any time the route, the position of the aid stations and timing points, to postpone the date and/or times of the Event. If the Event should be cancelled for any reason beyond the control of the Organizer constituting force majeure, the latter will offer, depending on the circumstances, compensation such as a postponement of the Event or a transfer of the bib to the following edition.
