SPORTING RULES

Updated version: 4 August 2026

PREAMBLE

Organiser: CREASPORTS ORGANISATION, a non-profit association governed by the French Law of 1901, SIRET No. 423935212, whose registered office is at 3 Impasse des Anémones, 83400 Hyères, France, hereinafter referred to as the "Organiser".

The terms "you", "your" and "yours" refer to you as a participant or consumer, or to the participant's or consumer's parent or legal guardian (over 18 years of age) if that participant or consumer is a minor in their country of residence.

Participation in the Event implies your express and unconditional acceptance of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale and these Rules. This document supplements the Terms of Use of the NJUKO online registration platform, available at njuko.net. In the event of any conflict, these Rules shall prevail over the General Terms and Conditions of Sale, which shall themselves prevail over the njuko.net Terms of Use.

The Organiser may revise and update the General Terms and Conditions of Sale and the Rules at any time; please consult them regularly. Changes apply immediately after notification by any means, including publication of a revised version on marathon-var-provence-verte.com. In the event of a material change, the Organiser will endeavour to notify you by email.

Important: role of njuko.net

Njuko.net, through which you registered, enables professional organisers to list and sell products and services. Although it facilitates transactions, njuko.net is not the seller or organiser of the Event's products and services. The sales contract is therefore entered into solely between you and the Organiser. The Organiser is responsible for sales and for claims or other issues arising from that contract.

I. SPORTING RULES

These Sporting Rules apply to every Event participant and form an integral part of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale. In the event of a conflict, these Rules shall prevail.

1.1. COURSES

The Event courses are:

- 10.7 km, 21.1 km and 42.195 km on roads and country lanes, in accordance with international road-race rules (IAAF and FFA). The marathon may be run as a relay by teams of 2 or 5. The Duo Run and Bike is held over the marathon distance.
- 26 km Trail: start in Rocbaron, through Sainte-Anastasie and Camps-la-Source, finishing at the Marathon Village in Brignoles.
- Marathon Hike: approximately 15 km, starting in Sainte-Anastasie, passing through Camps-la-Source and finishing at the Marathon Village in Brignoles.
- On the hills above Brignoles.
- Children's races will cover 1 to 2 km.

PROGRAMME

Saturday 15 May 2027:

- 2:00 p.m.: Provence Verte Hike starts in Sainte-Anastasie.
- 2:45 p.m.: Trail Var Provence Verte starts in Rocbaron.
- 6:30 p.m.: Official opening of the Marathon.

Sunday 16 May 2027:

- 9:00 a.m.: Individual Marathon, Run and Bike and Marathon Relay start in Châteauvert.

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- 10:00 a.m.: Half-Marathon starts in Carcès.
 - 10:30 a.m.: 10.7 km race starts in Vins-sur-Caramy.

1.2. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS - LICENCE - MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

To participate, you must reach the following minimum age by 31 December 2027:

- 16 for the 10.7 km race;
- 18 for the Half-Marathon and Run and Bike;
- 20 for the solo Marathon and Trail;
- 16 for the five-runner Marathon Relay, but only for the two shortest legs.

Age categories will be ranked separately in accordance with FFA rules. Checks may be carried out during the Event to ensure fair racing, particularly regarding age and medical eligibility.

Participation is subject to compulsory presentation of either:

- an FFA Running or Competition licence. FFTRI licences have not been accepted for FFA races since 1 January 2019; or
- for eligible non-licence holders, a PPS (Parcours Prévention Santé - Health Prevention Course), completed online at <https://pps.athle.fr>.

IMPORTANT - Participants residing outside France must provide a medical certificate stating that there is no contraindication to competitive athletics or competitive running, even if they hold a competition licence issued by an IAAF-affiliated federation. It must be dated, signed and allow the doctor to be authenticated. A foreign doctor's certificate must be written in French or English.

The certificate must expressly state "no contraindication to competitive athletics" or "no contraindication to competitive running". FSCF, FSGT and UFOLEP competition licences are accepted only if they expressly mention "athletics". Other licences cannot be accepted.

FFA licences are checked automatically during online registration. If the form validates your FFA membership, you do not need to upload the licence. Other documents uploaded online will be checked and an automatic message will state whether they are valid. Authenticity checks may also be carried out on site.

1.3. RACE NUMBER COLLECTION

Race numbers may be collected upon presentation of:

- your licence, PPS, or, for foreign participants, a compliant medical certificate; and
- proof of identity.

Collection takes place exclusively at the Marathon Village, Brignoles 83170, on Saturday 15 May 2027 from 9:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and on Sunday 16 May before the starts. The number must remain fully legible throughout the race, including in bad weather. **NO RACE NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED AT START AREAS.**

One person may collect numbers for a team or another participant if all documents are in order and copies of the relevant identity documents are presented.

1.4. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES AND 2027 FEES

Registration is exclusively through njuko.net.

Items and services included

Individual Marathon: chipped race number; bus shuttle to the start; one bottle of "Marathon Cuvée" wine; T-shirt; MVPV-branded cup; finisher's medal; live race tracking for supporters.

Individual Half-Marathon: chipped race number; bus shuttle to the start; one bottle of "Marathon Cuvée" wine; T-shirt; branded cup; finisher's medal; live tracking.

Individual 10.7 km: chipped race number; bus shuttle to the start; T-shirt; branded cup; finisher's medal; live tracking.

Five-person Marathon Relay: chipped numbers with each runner's time; one special Marathon Cuvée bottle per person; T-shirt; one branded cup per person; finisher's medal; live tracking; one race-number belt per team; shuttles to and from relay points; instructions for each relay point.

Two-person Marathon Relay: chipped numbers with each runner's time; one special Marathon Cuvée bottle per person; T-shirt; one branded cup per person; a medal for both finishers; live tracking; one race-number belt per team; shuttle to Châteauevert plus drop-off and pick-up at Carcès; start and relay-point instructions.

Run and Bike Marathon (two-person teams): chipped numbers; bus shuttle to the start for the runner; one special Marathon Cuvée bottle per person; T-shirt; one cup per person; finisher's medal; live tracking and free mobile supporter tracking.

Trail: chipped race number; Brignoles/Rocbaron shuttle; one bottle of Marathon Cuvée wine; T-shirt; branded cup; finisher's medal; live tracking.

Hike: Brignoles/Sainte-Anastasie shuttle; T-shirt; branded cup; finisher's medal.

FEES

The Var department, particularly Provence Verte, was severely affected by devastating wildfires in July 2026. Through the Event, we wish to support reforestation. Part of every entry fee will fund tree planting, with at least one tree per runner.

- Solo Marathon: €70 until 30/11/2026; €80 from 01/12/2026 to 20/03/2027; €90 from 21/03/2027, subject to availability.
- Half-Marathon: €35; €40; €45 over the same respective periods.
- 10.7 km: €25; €30; €35 over the same respective periods.
- Five-person Marathon Relay: €170 per team; €180; €190 over the same respective periods.
- Two-person Marathon Relay: €80 per team; €85; €90 over the same respective periods.
- Run and Bike Marathon: €80 per team; €85; €90 over the same respective periods.
- Trail: €35; €40; €45 over the same respective periods.
- Marathon Hike: €25 until 30/11/2026; €28 from 01/12/2026 to 20/03/2027; €32 from 21/03/2027, subject to availability.

MARATHON EVENING

On 16 May, a Marathon evening will include dinner, a live band and a DJ, creating the most festive possible "third half". Only 300 places are available. The price is €20 for runners and accompanying guests, by reservation.

Children's 1 km and 2 km races: free registration on site.

Special club rates may be available depending on participant numbers. Enquiries: contact@marathon-provence-verte.com.

Entry fees are stated in euros, including all taxes at the rate applicable on the registration date. Every registration is personal, firm and final and is non-refundable for any reason. Runners may purchase cancellation insurance when registering. Without this insurance, no refund will be made.

Each registration entitles its holder to one race number. Transfers are prohibited. Anyone transferring a number to a third party will be held responsible for any accident suffered or caused by that person during the Event. The Organiser accepts no liability in such circumstances.

For team entries, team members' names may be changed free of charge until 8 May 2027. From 9 to 13 May, changes cost €10 per name. No changes are permitted on 14, 15 or 16 May 2027.

Club, works council and group entries: a group leader must be appointed and will collect all race numbers and participant items. From the first registration, the leader will receive a link for adding runners over subsequent weeks and may share it so group members can add themselves.

1.5. OFFICIAL JURY

The jury comprises a Race Director whose decisions are final, assisted by judges and race officials. Aid stations are placed approximately every 5 km and at the finish. The maximum times are 6 hours for 42.195 km and 4 hours for the Half-Marathon. After the end-of-race vehicle has passed, participants must comply with normal road traffic rules.

1.7. GENERAL SERVICES

Road safety is provided by course marshals and police services; medical cover is provided by Protection Civile. Medical personnel may withdraw a participant for medical reasons.

1.8. SITE ACCESS AND SAFETY

Bringing dangerous or illegal objects onto the Event site, including drugs, firearms, blunt objects and explosives, is strictly prohibited. Participants expressly agree that security personnel may search persons and personal effects. Anyone refusing a search will be denied access.

The Organiser and security personnel may deny access or continued participation to anyone whose behaviour could disrupt the Event, including, without limitation, bringing any item liable to impede the race, traffic or other participants' safety, or any sign promoting a political, philosophical or religious opinion liable to harm the Event's image.

1.9.1. TIMING

Each participant receives an electronic chip attached to the back of the race number. It activates automatically at the start and checks passage at several points. A participant who does not follow the official course cannot be ranked at the finish.

In the five- and two-person relays, the race number fitted to the race-number belt must be handed over to time each runner and establish the overall 42.195 km time. In the Run and Bike Marathon, both athletes, wearing their respective numbers, must pass course checkpoints and cross the finish line together.

The electronic system is selected under strict reliability criteria. Despite manufacturers' testing, a very small non-detection rate remains. All finishes are filmed so that results can be corrected if necessary.

1.9.2. AWARDS

- Marathon: top 3 men and women overall and top 3 men and women in each category. For Masters: top 3 Masters overall, then first in each category.
- Half-Marathon: same awards as the Marathon.
- 10.7 km: top 3 men and women overall, then first in each category.
- Trail: top 3 men and women overall, then first in each category.
- Five-person Relay: top 3 men's, women's and mixed teams.
- Two-person Relay: top 3 men's, women's and mixed teams.
- Five-person Corporate Challenge: top 3 teams.
- Five-person Local Authorities Challenge: top 3 teams.
- Run and Bike: top 3 men's, women's and mixed teams.
- Children's races: medal for all participants and podium for the first three boys and girls in each race.
- Marathon Hike: no ranking or awards.

Cups, sporting prizes and regional products will be awarded to all podium finishers.

1.9.3. SPECIFIC RULES

Marathon, Half-Marathon, 10.7 km, Trail and Marathon Hike

As the starts are separate from the finish venue, shuttles will take participants to the start points. Full information and timetables are on the Event website under "Shuttles - Instructions".

Five-person Marathon Relay

The relay follows the individual Marathon course:

- Runner 1: Châteauvert to Correns, 8.5 km;
- Runner 2: Correns to Montfort, 5.5 km;
- Runner 3: Montfort to Carcès, 7.0 km;
- Runner 4: Carcès to Vins, 13.6 km;
- Runner 5: Vins to Brignoles, 7.6 km.

The relay starts simultaneously with the individual Marathon at 9:00 a.m. on 16 May 2027. The finish is on Cours Liberté in Brignoles. The route is available under “Events” on the website.

Each team receives five individual numbers, worn on the back, plus one front number fitted to a belt and passed between runners as the relay baton. Bus shuttles serve the starts and relay points; details are under “Shuttles - Instructions”.

Two-person Marathon Relay

The relay follows the individual Marathon course, with the handover in Carcès at the Half-Marathon point. It starts with the individual Marathon at 9:00 a.m. on 16 May 2027 and finishes on Cours Liberté in Brignoles. Each team receives two individual back numbers plus one front number on a belt, which is passed at the handover. Shuttle details are under “Shuttles - Instructions”.

Run and Bike Marathon

One mountain bike for two people; electric bikes are prohibited. A helmet is compulsory when cycling. Team members must remain within 10 metres of each other.

Only one team member starts the Marathon at 9:00 a.m.; the other waits with the bicycle a few kilometres later in Correns. From there, they complete the route together and may swap runner/cyclist roles whenever they wish. They must pass checkpoints and cross the finish together to be ranked. Each team receives two front-worn numbers.

Participants must reach Châteauvert by their own means and may park there. The runner starts with the individual and relay Marathons; the cyclist rides to Correns and waits at the meeting point. After the race, shuttles run from Brignoles to the vehicle in Châteauvert. Details are under “Shuttles - Instructions”.

Trail Var Provence Verte

Compulsory equipment: at least 1.5 litres of water and a mobile phone; waterproof clothing in bad weather. A bus from Brignoles will drop participants in Rocbaron. Details are under “Shuttles - Instructions”.

Marathon Hike

No medical certificate is required. An aid station is provided at Camps. Compulsory equipment: at least 1.5 litres of water and a mobile phone; waterproof clothing in bad weather. A bus from Brignoles will drop participants in Sainte-Anastasie. Details are under “Shuttles - Instructions”.

1.10. INSURANCE

Civil liability: in accordance with applicable law, the Organiser has insurance covering the financial consequences of its civil liability and that of its staff and all Event participants. For participants, cover is limited to accidents they may cause during the Event and applies in addition to, or failing, other insurance available to them. Evidence of cover is available on request.

Personal accident: participants without personal bodily-injury insurance, particularly those not licensed by a sports federation, are strongly advised to take out personal accident insurance. THIS INSURANCE IS OPTIONAL BUT STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. It may supplement, or replace, equivalent cover held through a sports licence. Information and an application form are available on the Event website under Registration > Insurance.

Property damage: the Organiser accepts no liability for theft, breakage, loss or other damage to participants' personal property, even when in its custody. Participants may not seek compensation from the Organiser for damage to their equipment and are responsible for arranging suitable insurance.

1.11. USE OF IMAGES

1.11.1. Participant's image

The Event may be recorded for public communication in any form, including photographs and video, on any current or future medium, in any format, worldwide, including for advertising and commercial purposes. Each participant expressly authorises the Organiser, its successors and assigns, including commercial partners, to record, reproduce and represent, without remuneration, their name, voice, image and sporting performance (their “Image”) for up to 10 years after the Event. The participant authorises the Organiser to grant Event partners sublicences for commercial and advertising use.

For advertising, promotional and/or commercial campaigns, each participant expressly and irrevocably authorises the Organiser and its successors, assigns and commercial partners to: (1) make any modification, addition or deletion considered useful for exploiting their Image as stated above; and (2) associate or combine it with signatures, straplines, slogans, captions, trademarks, distinctive signs, legal notices, visuals and any other element chosen by the Organiser to illustrate communications.

The participant warrants that no exclusive contract restricts use of their Image. Participation implies recording by the Organiser's official providers. Photos and/or videos will be available in the participant's "My Account" area and for one year in the Event website's "Results" section. Users may identify a participant by surname, first name, race number and region.

1.11.2. Event images

Any still or moving image of the Event recorded by a participant may be used only personally and may not be used for promotional or commercial purposes outside the Event.

1.12. PERSONAL DATA

Personal data supplied by participants ("Data") is intended for authorised Organiser personnel; the Organiser is the data controller. For its data-protection policy, see the General Terms and Conditions of Sale (I).

Any user of the live tracking application or the internet may track Event participants by entering their surname, first name and/or race number. After the Event, information about sporting performance, including results, photos and videos, is published on the Event website and results may be reproduced by any media outlet.

You may object to publication of your surname and first name in rankings, but this must be declared to the FFA and is permanently irreversible for all future FFA races. To object on legitimate grounds, notify CREASPORTS ORGANISATION, 3 Impasse des Anémones, 83400 Hyères, no later than 20 days before the Event so appropriate measures can be taken.

1.13. AERIAL FILMING

Participants are informed that drones may be used for filming on Event day; during all or part of their participation, they may be within 30 metres of such aircraft; any safety instructions issued must be strictly observed.

1.14. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

This is an ECO MARATHON. Measures are taken to make it as clean as possible. Littering, including paper and plastic packaging, is strictly prohibited. Amateur and professional drones are prohibited on and near the course.

At race-number collection, participants receive a light, foldable cup and must carry it to use the aid stations. THERE WILL BE NO OTHER CUPS ON THE COURSE OR AT THE FINISH. Bins will be available at each aid station and marked collection zones will be installed along the route. Participants must retain waste until they reach these zones. The Organiser may impose time penalties or disqualify participants or teams that deliberately discard waste elsewhere.

1.15. EQUIPMENT PROHIBITED ON THE COURSE

Bicycles, except for Run and Bike participants, wheeled devices and/or motorised devices are strictly prohibited.

1.16. ANTI-DOPING

The Event may be subject to anti-doping controls. Participants undertake to comply strictly with the prohibition of doping and all anti-doping control provisions under applicable laws and regulations, including Articles L.230-1 et seq. of the French Sports Code.

1.17. CHANGES - POSTPONEMENT - CANCELLATION

If circumstances require, the Organiser may change the course, aid-station and timing-point locations, Event date and/or times at any time. If the Event is cancelled for a reason beyond the Organiser's control constituting force majeure, the Organiser will, depending on the circumstances, offer compensation such as postponing the Event or carrying the entry over to the following edition.

II. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

If you ordered, for payment or free of charge, a Marathon Var Provence Verte product or service from the Organiser through njuko.net (website, mobile website or application), these General Terms and Conditions of Sale apply and constitute the sales contract between you and the Organiser. If you participate as a runner, the Sporting Rules also apply.

2.1. SCOPE

These terms do not apply to goods or services acquired from a third party, whether or not that party is authorised or licensed by the Organiser. They apply only to products and services supplied directly by the Organiser and ordered through njuko.net.

2.2. PRICES

Offers remain valid while displayed on sportips.fr. Prices exclude delivery and any additional services selected. Race-number fees are stated in the Rules. The Organiser may run exceptional promotions outside the listed pricing periods.

Prices are in euros, including taxes at the rate applicable on the order date. Delivery, gift-wrapping and any promotional offers or personal discounts ("promo codes") are shown before final confirmation. Prices include applicable French VAT; any change in the statutory rate will automatically affect prices displayed on sportips.fr, but prices cannot be changed once the order has been placed.

Orders delivered outside the European Union are not subject to French VAT and the prices displayed are therefore exclusive of tax. Customs duties, local taxes, import duties or state taxes may be payable and are the customer's sole responsibility, including declarations and payment to the competent authorities. Contact the relevant customs service for further information.

2.3. AVAILABILITY

Product and service availability is normally guaranteed. If an item becomes wholly or partly unavailable after an order, the Organiser will notify you promptly and offer either an equivalent product or service of equivalent quality and price, or a refund within 30 days of the refund request.

2.4. PLACING ORDERS

Orders may be placed only on njuko.net. Orders by email or post will not be accepted. By ordering, you accept njuko.net's Terms of Use and Privacy Policy.

After selecting products, you must confirm the order. Before confirmation, check the basket's contents, including product/service identification and quantities, and accept these General Terms and Conditions of Sale and the Rules. The Organiser will acknowledge the order by email with an order summary and payment receipt.

2.5. PAYMENT

Except in exceptional cases, only online card payments through the njuko.net registration form are accepted. Payments use a secure payment platform with specific controls to protect purchases and combat fraud. Card details never travel unencrypted over the internet; they are encrypted using SSL security protocol.

2.6. ORGANISER'S DETAILS - LEGAL NOTICE

The Organiser and publisher of <http://www.marathon-var-provence-verte.com> is Créasports Organisation, a non-profit association governed by the French Law of 1901, registered office: 3 Impasse des Anémones, 83400 Hyères, France, represented by its President, Mr Samuel Bonaudo.

2.7. DISPUTES, MEDIATION AND GOVERNING LAW

Any complaint arising from the Event must be made in writing, in French or English, stating the participant's surname, first name and race number. It must be sent within 10 days after the Event by email to contact@marathon-var-provence-verte.com or by post to Créasports Organisation, 3 Impasse des Anémones, 83400 Hyères, France.

III. HEALTH-SITUATION PROVISIONS

HEALTH PASS

We will apply the health rules in force on the date of the Event.
